

## SCHOOL LUNCH INFORMATION - 2022-2023

1. **Lunch and milk tickets are sold every day in the kitchen before school;** a ticket will not be issued until after lunch.
2. **Preschool milk will cost \$1.00 per day for a single ticket, \$5.00 for a five-day ticket, or \$10.00 for a ten-day ticket. This is payable on or before the first day of school. All checks are made payable to Hot Lunch Program.**
3. A ten-day lunch ticket costs \$30.00 or a five-day ticket costs \$15.00 if a parent **does not** work in the kitchen. A ten-day lunch ticket costs \$27.00 or a five-day costs \$13.50 if a parent works in the kitchen for a total of six days a year (not six days per child). If you cannot work all of your days, you can pay a sub \$25.00 per day to work for you. Students may a la carte their lunches for an additional price on some days for certain items. This money is paid in the lunch line with either the correct change or a \$1.00. No larger bills will be accepted. The child must notify their teacher at the time of the lunch count if they want to order a la carte so we can be prepared to meet their needs. A la carte items are noted with an asterisk (\*) behind the lunch item that may be purchased as an extra.
4. A one-day lunch ticket costs \$3.20 if a parent does not work in the kitchen and \$2.90 if a parent works in the kitchen.
5. If you are buying lunch tickets based on the rate for working six days in the kitchen, it is your responsibility to stop by the kitchen and sign up for your days.
6. "Extra milk" tickets cost \$10.00 for a ten-day ticket, \$5.00 for a five-day ticket, or \$1.00 for a single ticket; one milk is served as part of each meal at no extra charge. Money must be brought to the kitchen **before school** to pay for milk as **we do not accept money in the lunch line for milk and milk cannot be charged.**  
**Ala Carte milk will ONLY be white milk, no chocolate, per USDA**
7. If anyone other than a student wishes to eat hot lunch, the cost for an adult is \$4.25 and \$3.20 for a child. Adult lunches are regulated by the Federal Government.
8. Each day a student charges a lunch they are told verbally how many charges they have by the ticket puncher. After two charges, they are sent to the school office (**each day** they charge a lunch) to call home to make sure parents are aware of the charges and to make arrangements for payment. 9. If you plan on paying \$150.00 to pay for a sub for the year, it must be paid **at the beginning** of the school year before you will be allowed to purchase your children's lunch tickets at the lesser rate of \$27.00 for ten-day ticket instead of \$30.00 for ten-day ticket.
10. A yearly lunch ticket costs \$510.00 yearly (170 lunches) if a parent does not work in the kitchen or \$459.00 (170 lunches) if a parent works in the kitchen. **Any unused tickets are forwarded to the next year.**
